Murton Cricket Club asks its Junior players to observe the following codes of conduct:

- 1 **Play within the rules and embrace the spirit of the game.**
- 2 **Have the right attitude, be polite, respect the officials and their decisions.**
- 3 **Respect the opposition, line up at the end of the matches, shake hands and congratulate the other team.**
- 4 **Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.**
- 5 **Do not bully others, either at training, in matches, on social media or whilst representing the club in any manor.**
- 6 **As reasonably practicable attend outdoor and indoor training sessions.**
- 7 **No attendance at indoor or outdoor training = No match time.**
- 8 **Report for training and matches on-time, if you are going to be late or cant make it, inform your coach well in advance.**
- 9 **Report for training/matches with the correct equipment, footwear (trainers or cricket shoes), whites, tracksuit bottoms, sports top, coat/jumper/hoody, bat, protective box, protective gloves, protective pads, protective helmet and cap.**
- 10 **Do not move equipment which has been setup by the coach.**
- 11 **Where possible wear club training kit to training sessions and club whites to matches.**
- 12 **Always bring a drink of water to training and matches.**
- 13 **Pay your training subs/fees and sign in before the start of each session.**
- 14 **Do not smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club in any manor.**
- 15 **Do not consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on club premises or whilst representing the club in any manor.**
